Called AxisLink, the jointly developed solution integrates advanced tracking and real-time notification capabilities to support both survivors and justice system stakeholders. By combining Nexion Solutions' technology and platform strength with Leeb Innovations' technology, the solution enables proactive monitoring of restraining order compliance and immediate alerts in the event of a potential violation.

At the core of the system is a dual-sided approach: providing survivors with discreet, user-friendly tools to enhance personal safety, while also leveraging monitored technology to track the proximity and movements of individuals subject to court-issued protection orders. When a defined boundary is breached, the system triggers real-time notifications to the survivor, designated authorities, and, where appropriate, the monitored individual—helping to deter escalation and enable rapid intervention.

Powered by Atomic Mobile and leveraging the strength of AT&T's best-in-class network for connectivity, the solution is designed for use in conjunction with courts, law enforcement, and victim service organizations, ensuring alignment with legal frameworks and survivor-centered practices.



Key features include:

- Real-time geofencing and proximity monitoring
- Immediate alerts to survivors and designated responders
- Configurable notification protocols based on court orders
- Secure data handling with a focus on privacy and safety

“For law enforcement and Departments of Correction, this kind of technology supports both sides of the equation in domestic violence cases,” said Robert Iovino, former law enforcement officer and Co-founder of AxisLink. “It helps protect victims while also giving individuals subject to restraining orders a clear, enforceable boundary. It’s a smarter, more effective way to prevent escalation and increase compliance.”
